DISCOUNTS & COUPONS

FAMILY DISCOUNT. Families will receive a 5% discount for enrolling a 2nd or 3rd child. This discount is per child and applies to the 2nd and 3rd child, based on the price less the lunch cost.

EARLY BIRD. 4% discount for Early Bird Registration, with \$150 deposit due on February 15, final payment due April 1.

FRIENDSHIP COUPON. Any family bringing in a new camper can redeem our coupon worth \$15 (limit one per family).

REGISTRATION POLICIES

DEPOSIT. \$150 deposit per child is required with registration; the deposit is deducted from the full tuition amount.

BALANCE. Final payment is due May 15. Early Bird final payment is due April 1.

Cancellations before April 1 will be subject to processing fees. After April 1, deposits will not be refunded. Refunds for campers who do not complete their experience will be at the discretion of the director.
