

■ GOLDEN ARROW DAY CAMP → 2010 Parent Information Memo



At **Golden Arrow Day Camp** we are primarily interested in providing your youngster with the most beneficial, educational, and enjoyable summer possible. To do this we are providing you with the following information.

- 1. **Equipment.** Please provide your child with the following equipment and some type of bag to carry it in:
 - a. swim suit
- e. water bottle
- b. towel
- f. softball glove (optional, ages 8-13)
- c. plastic bag
- g. sweater (optional, for inclement weather)
- d. bug spray
- h. sunscreen

It is advisable to have your child's name on all equipment and the outside of their bag. A plastic bag for their towel and swim suit will help keep the other equipment dry.

2. Lunch. Our hot lunch program is optional. Children may choose to bring their own lunch. This year on Tuesday we will have our cookout. Two hot dogs, potato chips, and watermelon are served. You may sign up for the cookout without signing up for lunch. Cookout is included when you sign up for hot lunches. The menu is as follows:

- **4. Parents Welcome.** Parents are welcome to observe their youngsters swimming at the Gary Morava Recreational Center Pool. Swimming is from 12:00 to 1:30. Parents are also welcome to visit the camp any time we are in session.
- **5. Newsletters.** Camp newsletters will be brought home. Important camp information is provided in the newsletter. Please discuss this information with your children.
- **6. Water Show.** Please attend our annual watershow; details will be provided in camp newsletters.
- **7. Transportation Schedule**. The camp bus will begin picking children up from 8:20-9:15 a.m. Please have your child ready on time. Camp departure time is 3:25 p.m. A transportation notification will be sent out the week before camp begins.
- **8. Notification of Bus Driver.** If for any reason your child is not to be picked up please inform your bus driver the night before. The drivers phone numbers will be provided on the transportation notification mentioned above.
